RESTATED CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION
-OFALCOHOLICS ANONYMOUS WORLD SERVICES, INC.

Under Section 805 of the Not-for-Profit Corporation Law

We, the undersigned, being the Chairperson and the Secretary of ALCOHOLICS ANONYMOUS WORLD SERVICES, INC., do hereby certify:

(1) The name of the corporation is ALCOHOLICS ANONYMOUS WORLD SERVICES, INC., which is the name under which the corporation was formed.

- (2) The certificate of incorporation of ALCOHOLICS ANONYMOUS

 WORLD SERVICES, INC. was filed by the Department of State on the

 10th day of December, 1962.
- (3) The certificate of incorporation of ALCOHOLICS ANONYMOUS WORLD SERVICES, INC. is amended to effect the following amendments authorized by the Not-for-Profit Corporation Law of the State of New York (the "NPCL"): paragraph FIRST, the word "proposed" is deleted; paragraph SECOND, the purposes clause, is renumbered as paragraph THIRD, and a new paragraph SECOND is inserted which refers to the statutory definition of the corporation and its type; renumbered paragraph THIRD, the seventh word in the introductory paragraph is changed from "are" to "is"; renumbered paragraph THIRD, the word "to," at the end of the introductory paragraph is deleted; renumbered paragraph

THIRD, subparagraph A, everything following the phrase "...preparing publications and communications...," insofar as it is an historical reference to the assumption of the assets of Alcoholics Anonymous World Services, Inc., a predecessor stock corporation, by ALCOHOLICS ANONYMOUS WORLD SERVICES, INC., and the fact that The General Service Board of Alcoholics Anonymous, Inc. owned the stock of said predecessor corporation, is deleted as no longer relevant, and the reference to the number of groups served by The General Service Board of Alcoholics Anonymous, Inc. is described in general terms and merged into the language of renumbered paragraph THIRD, subparagraph B; renumbered paragraph THIRD, subparagraph B, the reference to The General Service Board of Alcoholics Anonymous, Inc., as a New York membership corporation is updated; renumbered paragraph THIRD, subparagraph E was deleted as no longer applicable; renumbered paragraph THIRD, subparagraph F is deleted and replaced by a newly added paragraph ELEVENTH, and the words, "...of Alcoholics Anonymous, Inc." have been deleted; the existing paragraphs THIRD and FOURTH have been renumbered as paragraphs FOURTH and FIFTH, respectively, and the description of the location of the Corporation's office has been reworded to more specifically comply with the NCPL; the existing paragraph FIFTH, regarding liquidation, is deleted and replaced by a newly added paragraph NINTH, concerning dissolution; the existing paragraph SIXTH is renumbered as newly added paragraph TENTH; paragraph SIXTH now provides for the designation of the New York Secretary of State as the corporation's agent for the service of process, and provides the post office address to which the Secretary of State may mail such process; the existing paragraph SEVENTH, providing the names and addresses of the original directors, is deleted; a new paragraph SEVENTH is added, in order to include language required by §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), regarding limitations respecting the corporation's activities, language indicating that the corporation is non-profit and therefore limited regarding the distribution of the corporation's earnings, and language defining limitations regarding the corporation's involvement in political activities; the existing paragraph EIGHTH, providing the qualifications of the subscribers to the original certificate of incorporation, is deleted; and, a new paragraph EIGHTH is added to include such limitations, respecting the corporation's activities, as would apply in the event the corporation is treated as a "private foundation.

(4) The text of the certificate of incorporation is hereby restated, as amended, to read as herein set forth in full:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Alcoholics Anonymous World Services, Inc.

SECOND: The corporation is a corporation as defined in Section 102(a)(5) of the Not-for-Profit Corporation Law of the State of New York (the "NPCL"), and is a Type B corporation under Section 201 of the NPCL.

THIRD: The purposes for which this corporation is formed are exclusively charitable, educational and scientific in nature, and in furtherance thereof the corporation is authorized:

- A. To constitute a service organization for the Alcoholics Anonymous movement and to engage in preparing publications and communications.
- B. To assist The General Service Board of Alcoholics Anonymous, Inc., a not-for-profit corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York (the "General Service Board"), which is the basic organization serving the thousands of local autonomous groups constituting integral parts of the Alcoholics Anonymous movement, in such duties and functions as may be assigned to it by the General Service Board.
- C. To carry out such services which relate to the attainment of sobriety and the maintenance of sobriety of persons suffering from or threatened with alcoholism.
- D. To engage in any and all activities calculated to assist in the voluntary restoration of individuals suffering from or threatened with alcoholism to normal life under conditions of sobriety and to conduct or participate in all classes of services calculated to be of help to persons suffering from or threatened with alcoholism.

<u>FOURTH</u>: The territory in which the operations of the corporation are principally to be conducted is the entire United States of America and Canada.

FIFTH: The Corporation maintains an office in the County of New York, State of New York.

SIXTH: The Secretary of State of the State of New York is hereby designated the agent of the corporation upon whom process against it may be served. The post office address to which the Secretary of State shall mail a copy of any process against the corporation served upon the Secretary of State as agent of the corporation is: General Manager, Alcoholics Anonymous World Services, Inc., 475 Riverside Drive, New York, NY 10115.



SEVENTH: A. The corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code").

- B. The corporation is not formed for pecuniary profit or for financial gain and no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any member, director or officer of the corporation, or to any private individual, except that the corporation shall be authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to or for the corporation in furtherance of one or more of its purposes.
- C. Except to the extent permitted by the Code, the corporation shall not carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation. The corporation shall not participate or intervene (including the publishing or distributing of statements) in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

EIGHTH: During such period or periods of time as the corporation is treated as a "private foundation" pursuant to the Code, the board of directors of the corporation (the "Board of Directors") must distribute the corporation's income at such time or times and in such manner so as not to subject the corporation to tax under Section 4942 of the Code, and the corporation is prohibited from engaging in any act of selfdealing (as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code), retaining any excess business holdings (as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Code) which would subject the corporation to a tax under Section 4943 of the Code, from making any investments or otherwise acquiring assets in such a manner so as to subject the corporation to a tax under Section 4944 of the Code, from retaining any assets which would subject the corporation to a tax under Section 4944 of the Code if the corporation had acquired such assets, and from making any taxable expenditures (as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Code).

NINTH: In the event of dissolution of the corporation, all of the remaining assets and property of the corporation shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation and for the necessary expenses thereof, be distributed to the General Service Board, provided that it then is qualified as a tax-exempt organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. If the General Service Board

is not so qualified as a Section 501(c)(3) organization, then the assets and property shall be applied as determined by the Board of Directors, and as approved by a Justice of the Supreme Court of the State of New York, for the charitable, educational and scientific purposes for which the corporation is organized by distributing such property and assets for the furtherance of the work of institutions with similar purposes and objects which shall qualify under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. In the event of voluntary dissolution, such institutions shall be selected in the discretion of the Board of Directors, subject to approval of the plan of dissolution and distribution of assets upon order of a Justice of the Supreme Court of the State of New York. In no event shall any of such assets be distributed to any member, director, or officer of the corporation, or to any private individual.

TENTH: The number of the corporation's directors shall be not less than seven nor more than twenty-five.

ELEVENTH: No one shall be elected to be a member of the corporation, nor continue as a member of the corporation, unless such person shall contemporaneously serve as a member and trustee of the General Service Board.

(5) This restatement of the certificate of incorporation of Alcoholics Anonymous World Services, Inc., was authorized by the unanimous vote of all Members of the Corporation entitled to vote thereon, at a meeting of the Members, duly called, and held on April 29, 2006.
